Authors should also include a brief biography and a photograph, or be prepared to supply them after acceptance of their paper for publication. We are also looking for responses to this year's editorial on page 3. If you wish to submit your list of the most important problems outstanding in Zubiri's philosophy, please do so by 1 October 2005.
